The use of absolute encoders eliminates the need for zero indexing allowing streamlined operation.

Finally all Series10K total stations feature IP66 dust and water protection, a 10,000-point internal memory, a password function preventing unauthorized instrument use. With the exception of the 6 second model, all models have a CF memory card option.
